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Sandro Teti is a publisher, journalist, expert at international relations and consultant for internationalization, communication and corporate institutional relations.

He holds a degree in Political Science with grade 110/110 cum laude from the State University of Milan. From 1981 to 1984 he lived and worked in the Soviet Union, in Moscow, at the press agency Novosti.

He is owner and founder of the publishing house "Sandro Teti editore" (www.sandrotetieditore.it) and of the business development services company "Teti Consulting" (www.teticonsulting.com). Since 2003, he directs the "Alferov Foundation in Italy" (www.alferov.it), a subsidiary of the "Alferov Foundation of St. Petersburg for the Support to Education and Research" of the Nobel Prize for Physics Zhores Alferov, Vice President of the Academy of Sciences of the Russian Federation and Dean of the Duma.

The publishing house opens in 2003 with many series. The oldest one, HISTOROS, is directed by the prominent professor Luciano Canfora, worldwide-known historian and writer, columnist of the daily newspaper "Il Corriere della Sera".

Since 2010 Sandro Teti publishes the historical cultural magazine "Il Calendario del Popolo" (www.calendariodelpopolo.it), of which he is also Editor in Chief. Founded in 1945, the magazine was revamped and re-launched by Sandro Teti after the death of his father Nicola, who had been the publisher for 46 years. Teti also acquired the publishing house "Nicola Teti & C. Editore" and now its catalogue counts about 1000 publications.

Between 2012 and 2015, Teti intensified its cooperation with Azerbaijan and Kazakhstan and their institutions for economic, cultural and academic activities, both in Italy and abroad. In the same year, with his publishing house, he published and disseminated in Italy several works about the two countries. Teti's cultural and consulting enterprises involve also the Russian Federation and other countries of the CIS area.

Between 2011 and 2012 he intensified the collaboration – both in terms of cultural activities both in terms of consulting services for internationalization and business development – with economic, diplomatic, cultural and academic institutions in Cuba, Venezuela and the countries of the Bolivarian Alliance for the Americas (ALBA).

In 2011 he was appointed in Italy – by rector of the Academy of Sciences in St. Petersburg, Nobel laureate Zhores Alferov – as representative and Head of institutional relations of the University.

The same year he was also nominated representative in Italy for "MAPP - International Association of

Writers and publicists of the Russian language" (*Meždunarodnaja Assočjacija Pisatelej the Publicistov*); published with "Sandro Teti Editore" translations from Romanian in collaboration with the "Romanian Institute of Venice" (*Institutul Cultural Român*).

Since 1984 and in the '90s he managed contracts with the Soviet Union and relations with publishers, ministries and agencies on behalf of the publishing house Nicola Teti & C. Editore, as well as a joint venture between it and the Russian publishing institution *Vneshtorgizdat*.
